Step 1: Go to www.mylion.com, select “Download on the App Store” for iPhone or “Get it on Google Play” for Android. Select “Install”.

Step 2: Select “Open”, then select “Register”, then select “Lions Member”.

Step 3: Enter your Lions Member ID, your email or cell phone number, create and confirm your password, enter your birth date; to enter the year; select 2017, scroll up to find your year of birth then select < or > to find your month and then select the date. Then select “PROCEED”.

Step 4: Check your phone messages or the inbox of the email address you registered at Step 3 for the 6 -digit code and enter it. **Congratulations!!** You are now registered!!

Step 5: Select “GET STARTED” and you will see 6 introduction screens, click “NEXT” on each screen and your profile will be created.
