Tri-Village Lions Focus on Hunger Close to Home



Neighbors helping neighbors. That has been both the theme and the focus of service by the Tri-Village Lions throughout 2025. The Tri-Village Lions have proudly led a coalition of community groups and neighbors in the Tri-Village area (Grandview Heights, Marblecliff, Upper Arlington) who are focused on feeding hungry children in our community. Only a small percentage of the children in our schools are food insecure, as compared with other communities throughout Central Ohio. That doesn't make those children any less hungry – it just makes them largely invisible to the agencies and organizations charged with confronting childhood hunger, who focus on areas with large numbers to be served. If we weren't responding to the needs of these children, no one else would notice them. We noticed.

The Lions have been joined in these efforts by the Northwest Kiwanis Club, the Upper Arlington and Tri-Village Rotary Clubs, the City of Upper Arlington, the City of Grandview Heights, the Grandview and Upper Arlington Schools, and many more. While some of the funds necessary to support the project have been donated by those organizations, more than half of the money comes from private donations from community members.

We sent home food during Spring Break, Thanksgiving Break, and Winter Break for youngsters identified by the schools as food insecure. During 2025, we collected, moved, unboxed, sorted, packed, and distributed 20,550 food items. That works out to more than 13,600 meals and snacks, sent home in 386 bags/boxes of food. We managed this with the help of more than 400 community volunteers, and generated more than 600 hours of community service (including more than 150 hours by Lions). Included within those numbers are 89 bags with foods specially selected and carefully packed for children with special dietary needs.

The Tri-Village Lions are proud to have served a significant role in this neighborhood coalition, addressing hunger in our community.






