We are pleased to inform you that MD13 GLT will be offering a Regional Lions Leadership Institute (RLLI) to the Lions of Ohio! All three levels will be offered this year. All Levels will be limited to twenty-five participants each Level, so you'll want to get registered ASAP since class size is limited!!

The Lions Institutes are indeed the "Ivy League" of leadership training. The institute at all levels will be a two-and-a-half-day immersion into developing and improving your leadership skills. This training will help you in your work life, your Lions career, and in your personal life as well. If you've ever thought about taking on a Leadership role in your club and beyond, this is the Institute for you!!

The institute is specifically designed to enhance your leadership skills. It will **not** be about fundraising, membership, or service projects. It will be about **Leadership!** This will be held at Deer Creek State Park, Mt Sterling, Ohio on October 24 - 26 and attendance is required for the entire event.

The cost to participants is \$185.00. The total institute cost per participant amounts to over \$300. Thanks to Grants from LCI and funds from the MD13 GLT committee you can attend for much less than the institute cost. Your only other expenses will be your breakfast and transportation to and from. Your hotel bill, 2 lunches and 1 dinner will be paid in full by MD13 GLT.

Below you will find the list of criteria and qualifications for all levels. Remember, space is limited to 25 participants for each level so make sure you get signed up before space runs out! We MUST have at least 15 Lions per level to hold this RLLI, so make sure you get the word out to **all** Lions.

#### CRITERIA FOR MD-13 LIONS REGIONAL LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE

- 1. Your member and club number are available on your membership card, from your club secretary, or on your membership information on LCI's website.
- 2. **<u>DO NOT</u>** send money with this application process, if your application is accepted, payment instructions will be sent with your acceptance notification.
- This information will be available soon on MD-13 Ohio Lions website <u>www.ohiolions.org</u> and select the GLOBAL LEADERSHIP TEAM tab or click on the Global Action Team (GAT) Logo (see above).
- 4. All applications must be completed online.
- 5. All applications must be received **NO LATER THAN September 24, 2025** to be considered.
- 6. Participants will share a room at Deer Creek State Park Lodge. A single room is available by paying a higher fee.
- 7. Click this <u>link</u> to complete the application process and, if accepted, you will be notified by GLT Chair, PDG Jackie Miller, of your acceptance.

#### Lions Clubs and Unclaimed Funds Reporting

Unclaimed Funds are money being held by organization or business that is owned by a third party. These funds must be turned over to the Department of Commerce when there has been no activity after 3-5 years and the holder of the funds can't locate the owner.

All Lions Clubs are required to file an Annual Report of Unclaimed Funds to the Ohio Department of Commerce (Revised Code Chapter 169). This may be a "Holder Report" if you have unclaimed funds, or a "Negative Report" if you do not. Lions Clubs usually do not have any unclaimed funds (abandoned bank accounts, safety deposit boxes, paychecks). But it is possible, such as in the case of an unclaimed raffle cash-prize. This money is owed to the winner. Note that an uncashed donation check is not an unclaimed fund as the money is not owed to the party that has not cashed the check.

In most cases, Lions Clubs will file an annual Negative Report. The negative report must be filed electronically. Paper reports are no longer permitted. All reports can be filed through the Ohio Business Gateway, or a simpler method is now available through the Department of Commerce website directly. See the step-by-step filing instructions below.

Ohio's annual unclaimed funds reporting period is July 1<sup>st</sup> through June 30<sup>th</sup> with a filing **deadline of November 1<sup>st</sup>** regardless of the club's fiscal year. Therefore, you should file your report between July 1 and November 1 each year. Failure to file could result in civil penalties of \$100 per day.

#### **NEGATIVE REPORT FILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Go to website: www.Ohio.gov
- 2. Click on the link on the top of the page: "Our State Government"
- 3. Click on the link in the middle of the page: "State Agencies and Departments"
- 4. Scroll down and click on the link: "Department of Commerce"
- 5. Scroll down and click on the link: "Unclaimed Funds Reporting"
- 6. Click on the link: "Launch"
- 7. Click on the link: "Submit a Report"
- 8. Click on the link: "Submit a Negative Report"
- Fill in only the required fields (indicated by red star)
   Note that Holder is your club name and Holder Tax ID is the same as your EIN.
   On the second page, verify the information and type your name, and click on submit.
- 10. On the Holder Summary page, click on "Print Summary" and retain this printout for your records.
