

Please be aware that scam and email phishing attempts have been increasing lately. Here is some information on what phishing is and how to spot it: https://www.phishing.org/what-is-phishing In particular be on the lookout for emails that say they are from OhioLions, Inc, Lion Office, Deborah/Debbie Luttrell, or Mike Kerek. One today that was received by multiple Lions had the subject line "Complete With: DOS: 09/18/2025 / Request for Proposal -PO#40845/.pdf". This is a scam/phishing attempt- do not click! The email looks like this:



If you are ever not sure about a message you are receiving, contact the Lion directly by a known safe email, phone number, etc. Keep your information safe and CHECK before clicking!


