- Our bank balance is \$20,677.85.
- Donations received during 2020-2021 were \$2,773.71.
- We have secured a \$100,000 D&O policy with \$50,000 surety theft coverage.
- The individual sponsored by Brilliant Lions health has improved and he has had his first cataract surgery. We are waiting on the invoice.
- We paid \$540 for vision therapy aid for a child from OH7. This case was sponsored by Amanda Lions.
- We approved surgery to remove dense cataracts from a young man sponsored by the Richmond Lions, OH-3. The surgery needs to be done under general anesthesia and he was evaluated for the procedure the first of the month.
- We approved the individual sponsored by the by the Richmond Lions, OH-3, for an evaluation and possible purchase of low vision reading glasses. We are waiting on the written evaluation.
- We held a grant application training program on June 5 for Board members. Six members participated. The program was taped for the other members to watch. This was provided by Lion Loretta Sweeney via ZOOM.
