Report

The Ohio Lions Building Trustees met for their first quarterly meeting of the 2021-22 Lions year in mid-July. Trustees present were from Districts OH1, OH2, OH4, OH5, OH6 and OH7. Also joining was F&P Liaison, PDG Norman Cupps. Our trustee from OH3 was excused.

The new windows for the 2nd floor and the rear ground level window have been installed. Installation was completed early in the spring. There are a few minor touchups to be completed yet by the contractor. The Building Trustees are proud of the new windows and their installation have made a marked improvement in the looks of the building.

Please take note of the new awnings on the building. These new awnings were installed following the completion of the installation of the new windows. The new awnings really give the Lions State Office Building a fresh new look that all Lions should be proud to see.

We are currently reviewing the trash removal service from Waste Management and have received a proposal for trash service pickup from the Boren Bros Trash Service at a much-reduced fee. However, we have discovered that Waste Mgt claims to have an automatic renewal contract for service that is valid until September 2021. We have requested to not renew the annual automatic renewal of the contract with Waste Mgt. We are awaiting the release of this contract immediately but no later than September 1st. Upon confirmation of the contract release from WM we will be finalizing a contract with the Boren Bros.

The service and mowing of the “large lawn area” of the building is being taken care of by the Grove City Noon Lions Club as a club service project at no cost to the Ohio Lions. When you meet a member of the club please acknowledge their service and thanks them.

The Building Trustees will continue to diligently serve the Lions of Ohio. We do our utmost to operate and maintain the Ohio Lions State Office Building in a responsible manner.
