Highlights for 2023-2024:

- <u>Service Reporting</u> To have 100% Service Reporting by all Ohio Leo Clubs.
- <u>Ohio Leo Convention</u> A convention is tentatively planned for February 24, 2024. We are working with All Occasions Catering and Banquet Facility in Waldo, Ohio.
- <u>Cub Program</u> To encourage Lions Clubs throughout Ohio to form Cub Clubs.
 Children ages 3-12, *Lions family members or not*, are welcome into these clubs.
- <u>Service Projects</u> To encourage all Ohio Leo Clubs to participate in Ohio Lions service activities separately or with their sponsoring Lions Club.
- <u>Peace Poster/Peace Essay</u> To work with all Lions Clubs to sponsor Peace Poster and/or Peace Essay Contests.
 - LCI Peace Essay Contests are open to visually impaired children only.
 - Theme is "Dare to Dream"
- <u>Liberty Day Booklets</u> To promote Liberty Day booklet sales/distribution throughout Ohio.
- <u>James T. and Betty Coffey Grants</u> To promote awareness of these grants that are available throughout Ohio.
- <u>Sharing Information</u> To continue to share Youth information with Lions and Lions Clubs around the state.

Activities upcoming:

- Leo Convention February 24, 2024
- Peace Poster/Peace Essay Contests to District Governors by November 15, 2023.
- Scholarship opportunities Lions International Trading Pin Club (LITPC), Ohio Lions Youth (2 scholarships \$500 each).
- Leo Club of the Year
- Leo of the Year (both Ohio Leo of the Year and LCI Leo of the Year)

News: Ohio had an LITPC scholarship winner (per PID Steve Sherer).
