Our goals for 2021-2022 year will include some of the same goals as during the previous Lions' year and some additional goals based on all areas for which the committee has some responsibility or impact. We provide updates in our report at each Council of Governors' meeting. Each Youth committee member will share information in their district reports at the District Cabinet meetings.

GOALS:

- Reporting
  - District Youth/Leo Coordinators will work with Leo Club Advisors and Lions Club secretaries to update each Leo Club's MyLCI information by August 31, 2021.
  - District Coordinators will work with Leo Club advisors to report service activities in MyLion and membership information in MyLCI monthly.
- Participation – Service beyond the local Leo club
  - The Youth committee will encourage all Ohio Leo Clubs to participate in service activities with sponsoring Lions Clubs, Districts, and other groups throughout the year.
  - To promote a state Youth/Leo project. This may be replaced by a project with a Lions Club, District, or other group or be a project that will be completed at the state Leo Convention. This goal is tentative, based on COVID-19 restrictions in-place for groups and schools.
  - To encourage youth and Leo Club members throughout the state to volunteer at Camp Echoing Hills and/or Kamp Dovetail.
- Participation – Leadership
  - To encourage Leos and Advisors to participate in and support a state Leo Convention. Activities at convention will include Leadership sessions.
  - To encourage Leo and Advisor participation in Ohio Lions Youth Zoom information sharing meetings.
  - To sponsor Leo Advisor Training Sessions, equipping new and existing Leo Club Advisors with information regarding their duties.
  - To provide information to Leo Clubs regarding LCI-sponsored Leo Forums and other Leo activities.
- Awareness – Youth Activities
  - To share Youth information with Lions and Lions Clubs throughout the state.
  - To promote Liberty Day booklet sales/distribution along with Constitution Day (September 17<sup>th</sup>) and Liberty Day (March 16<sup>th</sup>).
  - To encourage Peace Poster/Peace Essay Activities in each district.
  - To encourage Lions Clubs to make use of the Lion Cub Program to increase membership Lions Clubs.
  - To promote awareness of the James T. and Betty Coffey Grants which are available through the Ohio Lions Foundation. To promote Lions Quest.
- Resources and Recognition
  - Scholarship Availability
  - LITPC Scholarships available to all Ohio Leo Clubs through partnerships with the Ohio Lions Pin Traders Club.
  - Ohio Lions Youth/Leo Scholarship that is awarded to an active Leo Club member.
