Finance and Long-Range Planning Committee Report of actions from the Council of Governors meeting

February 2019 report

Action Items

- 1. At our request, the Constitution and By-Laws presented a first reading on the proposed dues adjustment. The plan is to have the adjusted dues allocation in place for the 1H2019 billing.
- 2. The COG approved the \$5000 from the Youth fund requested by the Youth Committee to send 2 Leos and chaperones to the 2019 Leo convention in Az. A concern was raised by the possibility of IRS 1099 forms needing to be sent out if any person receives more than \$599.00. The Youth and Leo chairs will decide how to best proceed.
- 3. Council agreed to put elimination of the Financial Oversight Committee and the Band Committee on the state convention ballot. Council also agreed to put adding the Compliance Committee as a new state committee.
- 4. Council approved the revised the second quarter financials report.
- 5. The F&P Chair encouraged Council members to take, review the backload of old boxes of records and dispose per the Policy Manual. I don't think anyone took a box of records.
- 6. Council agreed to spend money for the yearly software update for the archiving system. Since MD13 Ohio Lions Inc. now owns the archiving hardware this becomes only an \$1100/year cost.
- 7. Council approved moving \$300 from the Youth Committee to the Quest Grant Committee to finish the 25% local funds requirement. The grant ended January 2019 so the Grant Committee will work on final reporting documents.
