SIGHT AND HEARING COORDINATOR

Third Quarter Report

Our district has reported some vision screening activity this quarter. Using the PlusOptix, there have been 3 reported screenings since the beginning of November 2019. There were 56 Under 6 screenings with 3 referrals, and 4 Over 6 with no referrals. That brings the total of PlusOptix screenings to 204 Under 6 with 16 referrals, 128 Over 6 with 17 referrals. Grand Total is 332 screenings with only 33 referrals (or 9.9%). The Sure Sight machine was not reported as used this quarter, so it's total remain at 7 screenings for Under 6 and 10 screenings for Over 6 with none referred. The Spot machine has no reported usage this Lions year.

I received requests for eye exams/glasses from MDS Debbie Luttrell totaling 24 persons. Only 2 requests came from school nurses for students. One school nurse never responded to my messages, and the other nurse said the child had moved and left no forwarding address. The other requests were sent out to local clubs or to the Sight and Hearing Fund for assistance. The majority of these were from the greater Columbus area. I have had no reports of eye exams or eyeglasses provided by individual clubs.

Donations to our Eye Related Agencies have increased since the first of the year. Twelve clubs have sent checks either to me or through Bob Medley. I recorded the donations and sent the checks on to the respective agencies. Clubs contributing to date are:
