Highlights for 2023-2024:

- Ohio Leo Club Video Contest Information sent to Leo Club advisors. Contest will end in mid-January.
- Service Reporting To have 100% Service Reporting by all Ohio Leo Clubs.
 - Continuing to work with Leo Clubs to report Advisors in MyLCI and to report activities in MyLion.
