Training for Lions – Officers and Members

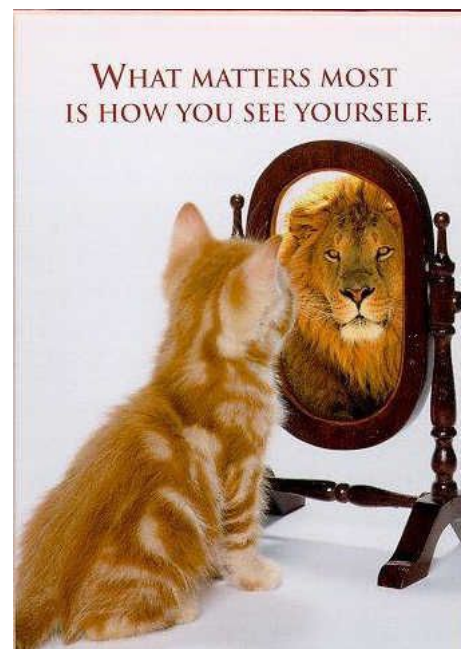
**When:** Saturday, June 12<sup>th</sup>
