At a time when the world is dealing with and focusing on the pandemic, let's not forget the children diagnosed with cancer. Remember that cancer doesn't take a break and over 300,000 children are diagnosed each year. They and their families need our support, so if you can, support LCIF and/or your cancer centers.

It's also important to remember that grants are available to Lions districts and multiple districts in amounts from US\$10,000 to US\$150,000. Projects must be implemented in coordination or collaboration with existing government or charitable childhood cancer medical facilities. And, if an applicant wishes to implement a project involving medical equipment or infrastructure, they may be eligible to apply for support through the LCIF Matching grant program.
