A little more information on Creston Lions " **Hug-A-Lion Day** event. Maury was busy talking to the public on all things Lions. supervising the cooking of hot dogs and Leos spinning cotton candy!

Lion Maury Murphy, LCIF # 1186133, is a **life member** of LCIF and is a role model for all Lions. Lion Maury has been in **perfect attendance** for **66 plus years**.

In 1962 Maury began making an annual visit to the Creston hospital where he visited with patients and distributed Christmas goodies to lift everyone's spirits at that special time of year and continues to do so. Maury also began collecting glasses to support the **Lions Vision Program** at our **Hug-A-Lion Day** his number was 50,243 and as of writing **today** he has collected**50,335 pairs of eye glasses!** Maury served as Secretary of the Creston Lions for 31 years, collected monies from the **LCIF Mints** for **20 years** and started the **Adopt a Highway Program** in **1962** in Creston, B.C. On Remembrance Day, Maury marches up the pavement to the Cenotaph then stands to attention in the cold to honor all our fallen heroes.

Maury is still very active in the community and still lives on the family farm they moved to in 1927. Truly, a man to admire!
