Purpose: To determine the voting privileges and meal charges at Cabinet meetings

1. The Immediate Past District Governor is a voting member of the District Cabinet as provided by the Constitution and By-Laws of Lions Clubs International.
2. Past District Governors who are Chairs of District Committees are voting members of the District Cabinet with all of the rights and privileges of other Cabinet members.
3. Past District Governors not listed above are non-voting members of the District Cabinet. A Past District Governor has the right of the floor and may speak on any subject under discussion by the District Cabinet; however, he/she may not make or second motions or vote.
4. Non-voting Past District Governors and their partners in service attending the Cabinet meeting are entitled to the meal when provided at the Cabinet meeting.
5. Past District Governors are expected to respond to the District Cabinet Secretary's meeting announcement/invitation if they will be attending.
