1. What defines me best:

So, on reflection, after struggling deeply with lack of confidence and extreme shyness in my youth, I have been molded and defined over time to be: self-determined - bordering on compulsive obsessive;); courageous (to jump into the unknown); serial student of holistic self improvement (mind, body and soul) and the inter-connectivity of all life (animal, plant, human); passionate environmentalist; compassionate humanist, constantly evolving.

2. What challenges me most:

My idealism and finding balance. All my life I've been a workaholic / project-aholic – all or nothing – often at the expense of personal health and relationships. I am now more determined than ever to practice balance. A friend once told me: "We walk a tightrope and have to find balance to get to the other side" – I love this!


My role model is definitely my mom, she is the root of the person I am. Consistent, confident, disciplined, focused on my goals and I am grateful to GOD for always being there.

A Daughter, a Wife, a Mother, a Friend, a French Teacher, a Homemaker, a Humanitarian and now A Warrior.


I am blessed with all the adversities and challenges that have made me who I am today, "A Stronger Soul".




