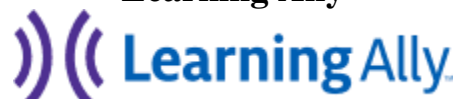

District Governor's Advisory Committee (Zone) Meetings:

- At least 3 Zone Advisory Meetings in 2020-21:
 - 1st – between 1st Cabinet Meeting in July and 2nd Cabinet Meeting in October
 - 2nd – between 2nd Cabinet Meeting in October and 3rd Cabinet Meeting in March
 - 3rd – between 3rd Cabinet Meeting in March and 4th Cabinet Meeting in May
- Club presidents, first vice presidents and secretaries are expected to attend and other members are encouraged to attend.

District Convention:

A District Convention will be held March 6, 2021. All voting delegates from each club are expected to attend in order to elect candidates for the offices of District Governor, 1st and 2nd Vice District Governor, District Librarian and District Director of GA Lions Camp. Clubs must be in good standing for their delegate(s) to vote.

Club secretary monthly/yearly reports

Club secretaries are expected to report membership monthly, even if there are no changes to report. This is easily done in MyLCI by clicking the button Report No Changes for the Month.

Club secretaries are expected to record the officers for 2021-22 in MyLCI or by submitting a PU-101 form electronically or by snail mail to LCI by May 15, 2021.

Service reports

Club secretary, service chair, president, or administrator can report service in MyLION at anytime during the month and can report past service for preceding months as long as it is within the current Lions year (2020-21). It is best to NOT wait to record all the month's service just before the end of the month.

Club treasurer calendar responsibilities

Club treasurers are to pay LCI, state, and district dues in July/August and January/February and to check MyLCI between those times for any additional LCI charges due to new members and store purchases.

1. ELIGIBILITY

All nominees living or deceased must have a minimum of ten (10) years of active Lion Service. Induction into the District Lions Hall of Fame signifies a Lion's noteworthy contributions to the ideals of Lionism through the Lions Club, District and community; it is not intended to be a longevity award. All living nominees must be current members in good standing of a District 18-I Lions Club.

2. CLUB NOMINATING PROCEDURES

A. A **letter of nomination** of not more than two double-spaced typewritten pages setting forth the individual's accomplishments in Lionism, home Lions Club, and community; Lions Awards and recognitions earned with dates received; and leadership positions held in Lionism including dates, must be **submitted to the President of the District 18-I Past District Governor's Association, postmarked no later than 45 days prior to the Second District Cabinet Meeting**. The letter must **include a statement of intention of the nominee to be present** at the presentation ceremony during the 2nd Cabinet Meeting and must be **signed by the Club President or Club Hall of Fame Committee Chair**.

B. The **nominating club must agree in writing to provide the necessary funds to purchase the plaque for each nominee** selected. Clubs will be billed by the PDG Association for each nominee selected.

3. SELECTION PROCESS

A committee of the three (3) most recent active Past District Governors, with the most recent serving as chair, will review all nominations and select nominees for induction into the District Hall of Fame. The chair shall promulgate a list of inductees to the President of the PDG Association.

4. INDUCTION CEREMONY

The President shall coordinate with the District Governor to ensure an appropriate induction ceremony is held in conjunction with the District's Second Regular Cabinet Meeting. The President is responsible for publicizing the Hall of Fame, coordinating nominations from participating clubs and procuring the plaques.

5. NOMINATIONS CATEGORIES

A. All District 18-I Past International Directors living or deceased may be automatically selected provided their club nominates and agrees to purchase the plaque.

B. Each Lions Club of District 18-I may submit two (2) nominations annually to be considered for induction into the District 18-I Hall of Fame

GOLDEN CHAIN AWARD Any Lion in good standing may apply for this award. Applications must be submitted no later than April 30, 2021. Application can be downloaded from the district website at <http://www.e-district.org/sites/18i/page-6.php> Forms are sent to District Chair Bonnie Linscott, at the address found with the link. (This is a State Award given in the district during the state convention.)

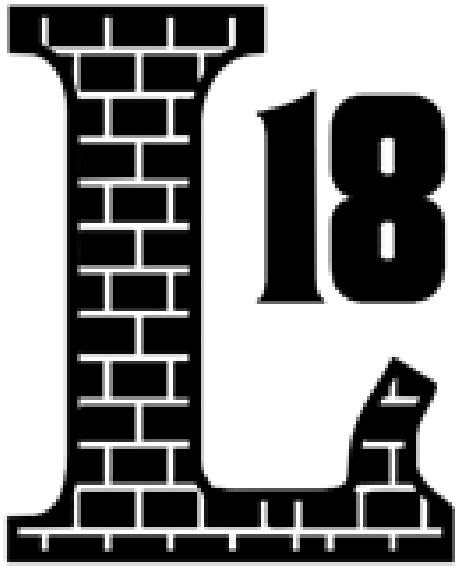

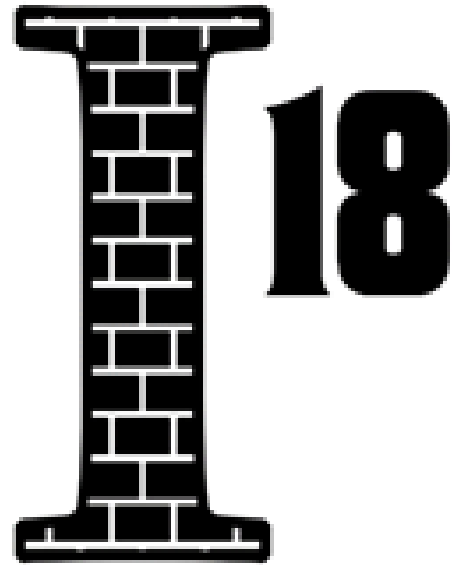

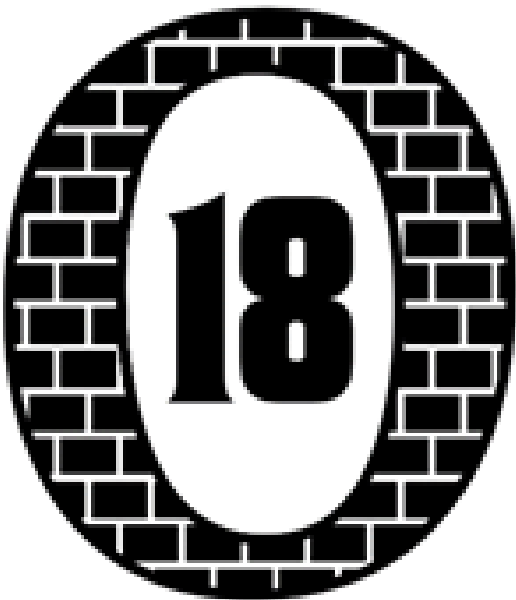
