- 5. a) 19-D Conference Leo reimbursement was discussed. The total costs for the registration of approximately \$795.00 US (includes hotel and meals) and flight of \$600.00US is \$1,400.00 US. The letter of request is filed with these minutes. A motion was moved by 2nd VDG Joyce and seconded by PDG Wanda that we support Leo Hannah with \$1,000.00 Canadian from the Y.E.P. travel subsidy account to go to the USA-Canada Forum in California. 1 abstained CARRIED
