From July 1st to October 18th, 2021 the metrics totals are as followed:

How many people were served? - 4,788

Service Activities – 26.

Volunteer Hours – 443.

Funds Donated - \$5,000.USD (The MyLION metrics converts to USD)

Funds Raised - \$1,400 USD
