The Laugh and Learn Society was created in Logan Lake to provide a day care for the community. Logan Lake Lions are pleased to donate \$10,000.00 towards this project. A space has been found, grants have arrived and construction has been on-going this fall. It is hoped that the day care will be open in the New Year. Logan Lake Lions are pleased to be able to support this worthwhile project.

We hope to be able to help Laugh and Learn in other ways but money was needed for start up.

ESS in Logan Lake set up a registration centre for evacuees in Nov after the flooding. Logan Lake Lions volunteered a total of 158 hours - greeting people, helping to organize the flow of people using a numbers system, providing coffee and cookies, filling in forms and sorting a huge array of clothes that were donated by people in our town. At the end of the registration period, all the clothes were packed up and sent to Merritt.

Our club has been super busy with lots of Christmas activities as well - decorating a campsite and light up the trees by the village office with hot chocolate and cookies served afterwards, a craft sale, a vaccination clinic for ages 5-11, turkey dinners for the school children, contributing to hampers and Skate with Santa, etc.
