



Used Hearing aids which can be reused by Island Deaf and Hard of Hearing

To those Lions Clubs which are collecting used hearing aids.:

In order to cut the costs and avoid sending in hearing aids which can not be used, we have consulted with Island Deaf and Hard of Hearing.

Island Deaf and Hard of Hearing require hearing aids from 2013 or more recent, behind the ear models only. No custom hearing aids which are molded for the patient's ears, and no **Costco or Beltone** hearing aids.

These are examples of behind the ear hearing aids which can be reprogramed and used again.

Please do not send in old worn-out aids and remove any batteries as they can corrode and damage the hearing aids.

Lions of BC Hearing Conservation Society will reimburse you for the cost of mailing as we also receive aids from this supply for our program. For those Clubs on Vancouver Island, Island Deaf and Hard of Hearing has offices in Victoria and Nanaimo and the Lions of BC Hearing Conservation donated \$15,000.00 to them to set up an audiologist booth. They have one now and low income people can join their organization for \$25 and receive refurbished aids, so that is another option on Vancouver Island. They are trying to expand this program BC wide but have not received funding yet. We can help by collecting used hearing aids.
