Also remember that even if you have no change in membership, you still need to report that. The reporting dates for the WMMR's (MyLCI) and Service Activities Report (MyLion) is the 20th of the current month, so if you still mail out your reports, you must have them in the mail to meet that deadline. I do recommend that if doing them online, that you do not leave it until the last day of the month.

As we are unable to do a lot of the projects we normally would be carrying out, it is a perfect opportunity to access some training online. Lions Clubs International offers many opportunities for this. If you got the website and click on Member Login, you then have 5 choices of 'boxes' to access – MyLCI, MyLion, Shop, Insights and if you scroll down, Learn.
