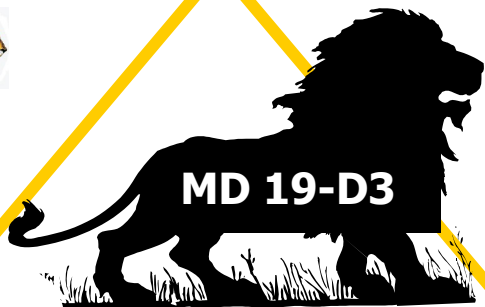

Registration is only \$25⁰⁰ CAN. And as an added bonus, you can be a part of this convention by presenting a seminar— MD19 is looking for seminars from MD19 Lions, Lioness and Leos to fill those 50 available seminar spots, that can be produced, recorded and shared— videos from 15 minutes to an hour on a topic you are passionate about are ideal. Lions Environmental Project: Pulling Invasive Knapweed

Pictured is the invasive commonly known Knapweed. it is found along most roadways, and any place that has had vehicle traffic as it is easily spread on the tires of any vehicle.

To pull, use a long sharp weed tool, or screwdriver and loosen the soil around the base of the knapweed, then pull out with as much root as possible. If it will not pull out, cut off at the base to prevent the weeds seeds from scattering further.

Place the weed in a plastic bag to keep the seeds from spreading, then toss with garbage. Keep track of the hours you spend doing this weed removal and send them to your secretary as service work under Environment. This is a project that you can do individually or as a group keeping safe distancing in mind.
