CHILDHOOD CANCER

International Childhood Cancer Day is celebrated annually on February 15th to raise awareness and to express support for children and adolescents with cancer, survivors and their families.

About 1 in 285 children will develop cancer before the age of 20.

Among children, leukemia is the most commonly occurring type of cancer (33%); followed by brain and nervous system cancers (20%) and lymphomas (11%).
