Helen Keller challenged the Lions Club to become the "Knights of the Blind". Thus our club identifies needs within our community and work together to fulfill those needs. In addition to the annual Blind Surfing Event, the Encinitas Lions Club works on a variety of projects designed to help the sight impaired, such as free diabetes and eye testing clinics, eye glass recycling, prescription eye glasses, Guide Dogs for the Blind and Audible Traffic

Signals throughout our city.

Our **BLIND SURFING EVENT** received international recognition when featured on the 2015 **Lions Rose Bowl Parade** float. Our own (sight impaired) surfer Sebastian De Long rode the float as well as other sight impaired surfers from our community.
