



Lions Float Decorating Trip December 1, 2018



Fellow Lions, it is that time of the year. Decorating has begun on the Lions Clubs International on the 2019 Tournament of Roses Parade float, **Rockin' the Vest!**

This is a unique opportunity to join the members of our District 4-L6 LEO Clubs when they travel to the Phoenix Decorating Company in Irwindale on Saturday, December 1st. Phoenix Decorating Co. is the 110,000 square foot (2.5 acres) facility that builds and decorates more than 15 floats for the Tournament of Roses Parade.

The process begins with the "dry goods". Every inch of the float must be covered in some type of plant material i.e. seeds, dried flowers, herbs, various grasses, and ground beans and lentils. The fresh flowers are applied the day before the parade.

Phoenix Decorating RULE: You must be 13 to work on the float. Wear socially acceptable "grubby clothing" because you will be working with a lot of glue. You must also wear closed toe shoes. The float barn can be very cold, dress appropriately. Bring some cash for lunch and souvenirs.
