In past years The Lions Club has paid for as many as 250 annual tests plus glasses if needed at no charge to the student or parents.

If the Lions Club had not stepped forward and provided this free service, many of the children tested would not have known they had a sight problem and might not have been able to afford the necessary glasses after their test.
