
SD Classic Lions at the International Convention Submitted By: Julie Perlas

Lions Remy DeRamos and Luz Galindez represented the SD Classic Lions Club at the International Convention in Seattle, WA. They joined Lion Alba Orr (SD Mission Lions Club) in her hotel room at Hampton Inn, who went to Seattle on July 1st. Aside from the PDGs that attended, they also met with Lion Dave Roberts (Del Sol Lions Club); RC Leo and ZC Virgie Williams (SD Forever Lions Club) and Lion Jimmy Boton who was there with his wife and other SD Executive Lions.

Highlights of the convention include the raising of the Lions Flag atop the Space Needle. It was raised by President Sid Scruggs III and stayed there for the duration of the convention. The Parade of Nations is believed to be the biggest parade Seattle ever had. It was participated by 10,000 Lions from 100 countries mostly dressed in their native costumes or club uniforms. The plenary sessions were well attended by the over 15,000 Lions in attendance and the speakers were fabulous. It is important to note that our very own SD Brotherhood Lions Club was a finalist in the Beacon Awards in the category of Best Environmental Project for their *"Earth Day, America Going Green"* Project; however, the award went to Umuarama Lions Club from Brazil. Next year, the site of the International Convention will be Busan, Korea.

Lions donated US\$1.26 million to LCIF during the convention. This included Campaign SightFirst II pledge payments of US\$1 million by PDG Aruna Oswal from India and US\$35,000 from the Lions of Wyoming Foundation. More than 70 Lions made individual donations of US\$1,000 to become Melvin Jones Fellows or advance in the Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow program. A record number of Lions clubs became 100% MJF clubs this year at the Melvin Jones Fellowship Luncheon. Twenty-four clubs attained this prestigious level, with every club member becoming a Fellow in the last year by donating at least US\$1,000.

Rick Heinick, a Corporate Vice President at Bausch + Lomb, spoke during the LCIF Plenary Session about our <u>Pediatric Cataract Initiative</u> partnership program. Bausch + Lomb committed an additional US\$350,000 to continue this program in the coming year. The keynote speaker at the final Plenary Session was Condoleeza Rice. It was here that Mr. Heinick was called back onstage and IP Wing Kun-Tam inducted him as a Lion. Not to be outdone, IPIP Sid L. Scruggs III stepped forward and presented Mr. Heinick with a MJF pin and plaque. Rick Heinick became a Lion and a MJF simultaneously.


