The following rules are to be adhered to by all Chili cook-off Contestants and/or assistants:

1. All chili ingredients must be listed and posted at the table with contestant chili.
2. The entry fee is \$ 25.00 per chili recipe entered.
3. There will be a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place prize.
4. All ingredients must be pre-cooked prior to the event – chili is to be brought “ready-to-eat” in a crock type pot to keep hot throughout the event. Please bring your own extension cord(s).
5. Contestants are responsible for supplying all of their own utensils & products relating to their chili submission. Spoons & cups for use in serving chili to the public for “Tasting” will be provided.
6. Contestants are to prepare a pot of competition chili, from which a sample will be collected for judging. All additional chili brought will be for public tasting. Plastic tasting cups and spoons will be provided at each table, an 8 ft table and plastic covering will be provided per entry. ***Depending on your assigned space, it is recommended each contestant bring an easy up 10x10 canopy for shade purposes.
7. Each contestant will be assigned a “number” and all contestant’s are required to have a name for their chili or for the Chefs competing. Also a contestant numbered cup will be given to the entrant in which their chili will be collected at the time of the official judging. Each contestant should verify that the number on the bottom of their judging cup is the same as the contestant’s number assigned to them by the Judging committee member at the start of the competition
8. The decision of the judges is final. Judging will be based on tally cards. There will also be a winner from the “people’s choice” attending the event.
9. Additionally there will be an award to the “best decorated” contestant table; be creative and have fun!
10. Each contestant is responsible for policing and cleaning up the area at the end of the day and removing all items from the area. Downey Chamber and The Elks Lodge will not be responsible for any items left at the event after the closure at 6:00 p.m.
11. Check-in and orientation time will be at 12 noon All contestants must attend the orientation
