All clubs are automatically entered, if copies of the Monthly Membership Report (MMR) & Monthly Service Reports are completed in the LCI Lion Portal by last day of month and Top Club Spreadsheet is sent to the District Cabinet Secretary by the 5th of the month following reporting month.
