

District 4L2-Club of the Year Award
Send report by the 5th of following month

This contest will run from July 1, though March 31. There will be three divisions: (A) Clubs of 25 members or less; (B) Clubs of 26 to 50 members; and (C) Clubs of 51 or more members. Two awards will be given for each division (top club and honorable mention). Awards will be based on the activity of the clubs in all areas, as reported on Activity Reports and Membership Reports.

All clubs are automatically entered, provided that copies of the Monthly Membership Report (MMR) & Monthly Activity Reports **are sent to the required Lions and Top Club Spreadsheet is sent to the District Secretary & District Governor by the 5th of the month following reporting month.**

Contest points are accumulated as follows:

1. MEMBERSHIP & ACTIVITY REPORT
 - Each membership report per month 5 points
 - Each activity report per month 5 points
2. MEMBERSHIP
 - Base number set in July is the same in March 10 points
 - Each additional gained beyond base number 5 points
3. SPONSORSHIP of a NEW LIONS CLUB 50 points
4. SPONSORSHIP of a NEW LEOS CLUB 50 points
5. ATTENDANCE at DISTRICT and/or CABINET MEETING
 - Each officer must be listed by name and office 10 points
 - Each Club member must be listed by name 5 points
6. ATTENDANCE at ZONE or REGION MEETING
 - Each officer must be listed by name and office 10 points
 - Each Club member must be listed by name 5 points
7. ATTENDANCE at MD4 CONVENTION, INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION, USA/CANADA FORUM, MD-4 LIONS LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE, OR OTHER LIONS LEADERSHIP VENUE.
 - Each club member must be listed by name 10 points
8. EYEGLASS COLLECTION & PROVISION
 - Each used pair donated 1 point **per 10 pairs**
- 8b Each new pair eyeglasses provided-quantity must be reported not \$ spend 5 points pair
9. HEARING AID COLLECTION
 - Each one 2 points
10. CELL PHONE COLLECTION
 - Each one 2 points

Attendance at any other Foundation Meetings that are none monetary.

Each Club member must be listed by name 10 points each

30 pts per event
