Float donors of \$50 or more receive a patch to add to their club service banner. Individual Lions can also make a donation and receive a patch for display.

"Ride of Your Life"

The package includes up to two hotel nights, one Grandstand ticket to parade (for spouse or guest), a ticket to reception with International President, a New Year's Eve breakfast with the Pasadena Host Lions, a tour of the float barn and transportation to and from the parade. Cost is \$5,000. The package is available to any Lion who wishes to ride on the float or a person sponsored by a Lion. Out-Walker Positions

The **Out-Walker** positions are available to anyone who wishes to participate by helping riders on and off the float and can walk six miles. Cost is \$1,000 and includes a ticket to International Presidents Reception, a New Year's Eve breakfast with Pasadena Host Lions, tour of the float barn and transportation to and from the parade.

Donald E. Banker Fellowship

Memorializes International President Don Banker who was the first International President to ride on the float on New Year's Day, 1992. **Donation: \$500 US**

Garry Lozaun Fellowship

Memorializes Past District Governor Garry Lozaun, founder of the Fellowship program and a 14-year member of the float committee. **Donation: \$350 US**

Wilt LeBlanc Fellowship

Memorializes Past District Governor Wilt LeBlanc, who was deeply involved from the project's inception in 1991 until his death in 2002. **Donation: \$300**

Chuck Overbey Fellowship

Memorializes Past District Governor Chuck Overbey, administrative director of the Fellowship program and member of the committee until his death in 2012. **Donation: \$250 US**

Jim North Fellowship

Memorializes Past District Governor Jim North, a member of the committee since 2002 serving as Vice President 2005-2006, President 2006-2007 and as Treasurer from 2010 until his death in 2014. **Donation: \$250 US**
