

Second Proposed Amendment
to the
Multiple District 22
Constitution & By-Laws

By-Laws Article IV, Section 4

Currently reads

Section 4. Certification of endorsement of candidacy for all International Offices, other than the Office of District Governor and Council Chairperson, shall be made by letter of the Chairperson and Secretary of the Respective District Cabinet, or Sub-District Cabinet, and the Multiple District Council as the case may be, which shall be addressed to the International Office and there arrive no less than ten (30) days, in the case of International Director candidates, and no less than ninety (90) days, in the case of Second Vice President candidates prior to the convening of the International Convention at which the endorsed candidate is to be voted upon. Certification may be made by telegram or cable, provided the same is confirmed by the required certification letter mailed within three (3) days after the day the telegram or cable is dispatched. **An endorsement shall be valid only for the two succeeding International Conventions following the date of filing thereof.** No Endorsement shall be valid until certification thereof is so made and received by the International Office. Certification of endorsement must specify the single office sought and no candidate may seek election for any office other than the office covered by the certification.

Proposed change to read

Section 4. Certification of endorsement of candidacy for all International Offices, other than the Office of District Governor and Council Chairperson, shall be in accordance with the Lions Clubs International Constitution and By-Laws. Certification may be made by telegram or cable, provided the same is confirmed by the required certification letter mailed within three (3) days after the day the telegram or cable is dispatched. **An endorsement will be in effect in accordance with the Lions Clubs International Constitution and By-Laws.** No Endorsement shall be valid until certification thereof is so made and received by the International Office. Certification of endorsement must specify the single office sought and no candidate may seek election for any office other than the office covered by the certification.

This way, when/if LCI makes changes that affect this (such as adding the Third Vice President), the Multiple District Constitution & By-Laws will not have to be changed.
