Eggnog Sugar Cookies

1 c butter softened

1 c vegetable or canola oil

1 c sugar

1 c icing sugar

2 eggs

2 tsp. vanilla

1 1/2 tsp. rum extract

4 1/2 c flour

1 tsp. baking soda

1 tsp. cream of tartar

1/2 tsp. nutmeg

Beat the butter, oil, and sugars until combined.

Beat in eggs, vanilla, and rum extract.

Whisk together flour, baking soda, cream of tartar, And nutmeg. Gradually add flour mixture to the butter mixture, beating until just combined after each addition. Do not over mix.

Line baking sheets with parchment paper Drop dough by teaspoonfuls onto baking sheets.

Bake at 375 for 8-11 minutes, or until edges and bottoms are lightly browned

For icing:

4 tbsp. butter melted

1 tsp. vanilla

1 1/2 tsp. rum extract

1/4 cup + 1-2 tbsp. milk or cream

1/4 tsp. nutmeg

4 - 4 1/2 cups icing sugar

Whisk together butter, vanilla, rum extract, 1/4 cup milk, and nutmeg, until smooth.

Stir in 4 c icing sugar, mixing until smooth.

Add additional milk or icing, as needed, for a thick,

but spreadable consistency. It should be thicker than a glaze, not run off the cookie, but easily spreadable.

Frost cookies, dust with additional nutmeg, if desired, and allow to set.


