- We are doing special tours in September for some of the people who are interested in supporting the Campaign. Hoping to work with the local Lions to put on this event.
- Easter Seals House is running at over 90% occupancy
- Drop Zone is in September. We are doing well in Vancouver and Victoria. Kelowna and Burnaby could use some more registrations.

We have 28 clubs in our District that have donated so far this year a total of \$102,531.02 for Camperships and Camp improvements.
