## Where do we find the invoices for our dues?

**Club Secretaries:** Each month, you should receive an email from Lions Clubs International, from a "noreply" email address, with your latest statement on your club's account. It might be a new invoice, which typically comes in June and December. If you added new members during the year, their dues will show on there, pro-rated to whatever month they were added. Account clear? It will show a balance of zero.

LCI does NOT email out invoices and statements directly. The email you receive looks like this:

Your electronic statement is now available online.

To view your statement, go to [www.lionsclubs.org](http://www.lionsclubs.org), click the Member Login link and login to the Lions Portal with your registered username and password. You can then view your statements by clicking the My Club menu and select Statements/Dues from the menu. Club Treasurers may pay online, or pay using your other, regular payment method.
