MEETINGS

8 May - The guest speaker Tasha Dykstra gave an informative talk on scams and identity theft, particularly those targeting senior citizens. Common scam calls include those threatening you for missing jury duty, fake bank calls about your accounts, phony romance calls, and threatening emails about money you allegedly owe. She recommends checking the legitimacy of questionable email addresses, checking your credit report regularly for suspicious activity, and using two-step verification when banking online.

24 April - Lynden's new Fire Chief Mike Noonan provided a brief history of his years with the fire department in California and how he came to the job in Lynden. A second guest, Lion Joan Fletcher of Arlington, outlined her club's involvement in testing school students in their district for hearing problems.

10 April - Speaker Lion Beth Marsau with the Knights of the Blind described how she interacts with blind and low-vision individuals and assists finding them tools and services to improve their vision.

27 March - Lion Kaddy Baldwin, a new member of our club, spoke about the Easter egg hunt she sponsors along with Guild Mortgage at Bender Field. In 2024 some 600 individuals participated.
