<p>* Shelter setup and management:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Establishing temporary shelters in community centers or designated locations</li> <li>-Providing shelter essentials like cots, bedding, and sanitation facilities</li> </ul>	<p>Safety protocols:</p> <p>Ensure all volunteers are properly trained and equipped to operate safely in disaster areas.</p>

Food and water distribution: -Setting up distribution points Delivering food and water to affected areas	Fundraising: <sup>SEP</sup> Actively solicit donations to fund necessary supplies and logistics for relief efforts.	
* Medical support: -Coordinating with medical professionals to provide basic healthcare services -Establishing mobile medical clinics		
* Psychological support: -Offering counseling and emotional support to disaster survivors		
* Community clean-up and debris removal: -Organizing teams to clear debris from damaged homes and streets		
* Infrastructure repair: -Assisting with minor repairs to damaged buildings and utilities		
* Long-term recovery initiatives: - Supporting rebuilding efforts, including home repairs and infrastructure restoration -Providing educational supplies and scholarships for affected students -Offering vocational training programs to help individuals regain employment <sup>SEP</sup>
