Community vision screenings	Organizing events to screen children and adults for vision issues at schools, community centers, or health fairs.	
Glasses collection drives	Collecting used eyeglasses to be refurbished and distributed to people in need.	Vision Grants from Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF) support Lions-led service activities that fight blindness and preventable vision loss and/or assist people who are blind and visually impaired in underserved communities. These grants primarily fund major equipment and infrastructure expenses. In developing countries where there is a shortage of trained eye health personnel, the Vision Grant also supports human resource training and consumables.

Eye health awareness campaigns	Educating the public about common eye diseases, symptoms, and preventive measures.	
Lions Eye Health Program (LEHP)	Participating in Lions Clubs International's LEHP, which focuses on eye health education and treatment programs	
Funding for cataract surgeries	Providing financial assistance for cataract surgeries to individuals who cannot afford them	
Collaboration with local eye care providers:	Partnering with ophthalmologists and optometrists to provide discounted eye exams and treatment options	
Low vision support programs	Assisting individuals with low vision by providing assistive devices like magnifying glasses or screen readers.
