Coordinating food and water distribution to affected communities.	Setting up temporary shelters and sanitation facilities.	Providing language training and cultural orientation programs for refugees.	Supporting community health programs including sanitation awareness campaigns.	Partnerships: Collaborating with local NGOs, government agencies, and other humanitarian organizations.	*Standard Grant -Provides matching funds up to \$75,000 for large-scale humanitarian projects -Typical projects include mobile health units, schools, and hospices
