TAKE NOTE: FRAUD ALERT SENT BY District Governor Brian Cox (22-W):

It has been brought to my attention that outside parties are attempting to defraud Lions Clubs in our district by the following method.

An email is sent to the club treasurer, supposedly from the club president, asking for a specific amount of money to be wired to a bank account and this transaction must take place immediately. The email includes routing numbers and other seemingly legitimate banking information.

Please check the email for valid email addresses and do not wire any funds that have not been approved by your club and/or your board of directors.

Random Act of Kindness

To help celebrate the 100th anniversary of Lions Clubs International (1917-2017) "Random Acts of Kindness" is a new outreach program started Taylorsville-Winfield Lions Club, District 22W. Not our idea, but one copied from another Lions Club in our area. Every meeting two members whose names are drawn at random are given \$50.00 cash from our treasury. Each has six weeks to GIVE the money away to a complete stranger. Maybe a young family buying food at the grocery, maybe a teacher who has done something special for his or her students or a member of our Armed Forces standing in line at McDonalds... It has to be anyone other than a family member or friend. We just give it away in a "random act of kindness"... The recipient gets the money in an envelope with a note telling them it is a gift from the Taylorsville-Winfield Lions Club and theirs to spend any way they want. Then the member has to report back about the details (no names) of who and why they gave them the money.
