## White Cane Projects- Increasing Awareness

Blind and visually impaired people in many countries use the familiar white cane with a red band at the bottom as a means of assisting with independent mobility. Lions help increase awareness of this "symbol of independence" – and the laws governing its use – during international white cane events. White Cane Safety Month is October, White Cane Day is October 15, White Cane Days are the third week of May. They are traditionally the time Lions raise money for their sight projects for children and adults, but White Cane Days can be held anytime during the year.

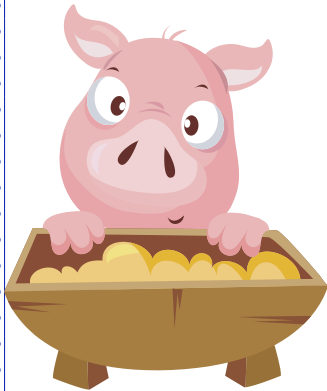
