## A Message from our District Governor

We are looking for quality members and not just faces. Our district is growing older and we need fresh people to carry this district forward.

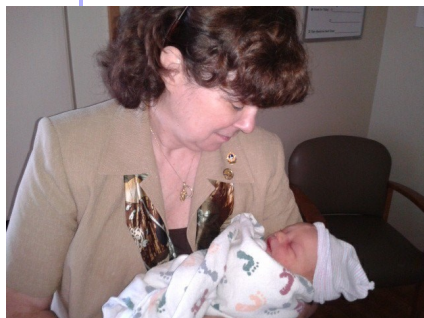
