Anyone making more than this is considered OVER SCALE by the United States Government guidelines. However, the Middle Tennessee Lions Sight Service examines each case on an individual basis. Barring extenuating circumstances, each Lions Club should see that these guidelines are met.

MTLSS requires that all applicants first contact Human Services, Department of Blind and Visually Impaired Services to see if they have a program to help them. With a letter of denial from Human Services, MTLSS can accept an application. MTLSS requires that all sponsored patients provide proof in current income and may be in the form of a current income tax return or a copy of the last payroll check or social security check.

If a patient is a minor, they MUST be accompanied by one of the parents or legal guardian.
