### > GOVERNOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Lions of District 2-T3,

There is no finish line. However, Lion Ralph McCain's year as Governor of District 2-T3 will begin on July 1 and mine will end.

We have lofty goals for the current year. We want a net gain of 70 members for our district. As I write this, we have a net loss of 4 members for the year. However, we have gained 18 members so far in June. Keep up the good work. If you have prospects who are ready to join, by all means, welcome them in and report them on MyLCI.

I am grateful for the Lions who have come forward to help with GMA-Global Membership Approach. Continue that work. I intend to remain right there with you. My vision is to build a district-wide team, along the lines of how West Texas Lions Hearing, Inc. has formed. With that kind of positive energy devoted to forming new clubs and strengthening existing clubs, membership growth will become a continuing reality. Already, El Paso Special Needs has reformed as Heroes of El Paso Lions Club. Look for great things from them.

We have met most of our service goals, having surpassed our goals (see actual numbers in parentheses) for number of projects reported on MyLion (almost 500), our goals for number of people served (almost 72,000) and hours of service (over 10,000). A great year. About twice as many clubs have reported service on MyLion during the current year than did last year. However, we are still short of 20 clubs reporting. In fact, we still have 20 clubs that have NOT reported a single service project on MyLion. I know you are serving your community – please report it. A couple of clubs are within one of reporting service in all five global cause areas. Please take another look at MyLion.

Donations to LCIF are still about \$5,000 short of our goal. However, something very gratifying has happened: several clubs that had not been giving to LCIF made significant contributions or they have significantly increased their contributions. I'll take that any year – more clubs supporting the primary charity of Lions International. Thank you. Continue the good work.

By and large, we have met our other goals, from training, to making our district meetings available both online and in person, and we have worked together to solve problems with technology as they have come to our attention. Many hands have made the work light.

Goals are just numbers, what I am proud of is you, the Lions of District 2-T3 who have done so much and done it with so much joy.






Monahans Lions Club "Sweet and Cool"
