Dr. Kathleen (Kathy) Summers was born to Josephine and Raymond (Red) Sinagra in Pittsburgh, PA. Unfortunately, Red passed away in 1962 while her mother still lives in Pittsburgh. She has two younger brothers, George and Ray, who also live in Pittsburg with their families. As DG Kathy says, she left Pennsylvania as fast as she could.

Arriving in Texas, Kathy, received her Doctor of Chiropractic in 1985. She is currently in practice with her husband, Dr. William, Bill, Summers and her son, Dr. Chris Summers. Dr. Chris and his finance, Kelsey Karon, will be married September 29th in Llano, Texas.

Kathy has been a Lion member in Andrews, Texas since 2000. She worked her way through the positions of Tail Twister, Director, and Vice President; and then became the first female President in the 77-year history of the Andrews Lions Club and the only female to hold the office of President twice. Texas Lions Eyeglass Recycling Center appointed her as director from 2015 through 2018. Kathy started serving her District 2T-3 in 2015-2016 as Zone Chair 2A, and Camp Improvement Committee Texas Lions Camp since 2017. She was then elected as 2nd Vice District Governor in 2016-2017, 1st District Vice President from 2017-2018 and District Governor in 2018-2019.

DG Dr. Kathy is dedicating this year to her daughter, Tiffany, who passed away in 2009 at the age of 20.

2018 - 2019 CLUB EXCELLENCE AWARD PROCESS

To qualify the club must be chartered for 6 or more months prior to the end of the fiscal year, further the objectives of the association, adhere to the association's constitution and by-laws and policies, and meet the requirements noted below during the fiscal year.

- **SERVICE** The club has conducted at least three service projects.
- **CONTRIBUTION** The club has made a contribution to LCIF.
- **❖ MEMBERSHIP DEVELOPMENT** The club achieved a net growth in membership (including branch club member when applicable) <u>or</u> sponsored a new club. New members attended an orientation and were properly inducted into the club.
- **COMMUNICATION** The club has publicized the club's service activities to the public through local media and effectively communicated activities to club members.
- ❖ LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT All officer positions were filled in accordance with the constitution and by-laws by qualified Lions, the club was represented at zone meetings and a majority of the club officers participated in a leadership training program. The training program could include training offered at the zone, district, multiple district or International level. Online courses from the Lions Learning Center, participation in a Club Quality Initiative (CEP) Workshop or completion of the Certified Guiding Lion course also count toward the award.
- **CLUB ACTIVITY** The club has hosted regular and meaningful club events and reported Membership, Service Activities, and New Club Officers in a timely manner.
- ❖ CLUB IN GOOD STANDING The club is not in status quo and International dues and new member entrance fees have been paid in full. No more than US \$50 in any other expense due to LCI is outstanding beyond ninety (90) days.

2-T3 CULLEN AKINS AWARD THE CULLEN AKINS LEADERSHIP AWARD

The purpose of the Cullen Akins Leadership Award is to honor the memory of a respected and dedicated Lion of District 2-T3, Lion Cullen Akins. Each Lions Club in District 2-T3 is eligible to nominate from its membership one Lion to be a candidate for the Cullen Akins Leadership Award, which will be funded and presented by the Past District Governors of District 2-T3 (no District funds are utilized for this award). A specially engraved watch will be presented to the winner at the annual District Convention banquet. Eligibility for the Cullen Akins Leadership Award is based on the following:

- 1. Outstanding service in Lionism based on the <u>current</u> Lion year shall be the primary consideration.
- 2. Nominee must be a member in good standing of a Lions Club in District 2-T3 during the current year.
- 3. Nominee should have an above average attendance record and be involved in Lions activities in his/her club first, and the District, State, and International levels thereafter.
- 4. Those not eligible for nomination are previous winners, Past District Governors, current cabinet members such as Zone and Region chairpersons, Cabinet Secretary or Treasurer, or Vice District Governor (other cabinet committee chairpersons are eligible for consideration).
- 5. The nominee must be present at the annual District Convention banquet.

An outline or biography of the nominee must be sent to the immediate Past District Governor. This information must be no longer than one double spaced typewritten page and must be submitted no later than April 1, preceding the annual District Convention. Copies will be sent to all Past District Governors of District 2-T3 for their consideration. Selection of the winner will be by the Past District Governors on a secret ballot prior to the annual District Convention.

Other Recognitions and Honors

There are numerous additional ways clubs and individuals are recognized for outstanding service to their communities, their clubs, District 2T3, Texas Multiple District or Lions Clubs International. Several of these are described below.

Melvin Jones Fellowship

The Melvin Jones Fellowship (MJF), established in 1973, recognizes donations of \$1000 to the Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF). As recognition of humanitarian work, a MJF is an honor presented to those who donate \$1000 to LCIF or to people for whom a donation was made by others. Contributions can be made by individuals (including non-Lions), clubs or districts. Donations may be in one sum, or in installments of a minimum of \$100 over a five-year period. Melvin Jones Fellows receive an attractive lapel pin, a plaque and a congratulatory letter. In addition, the names of Melvin Jones Fellows are displayed on an electronic marquee in the lobby of Lions Clubs International Headquarters.

Texas Lions Fellowship

The Texas Lions Fellow Award is given to honor a person or business in whose name a monetary gift in the amount of \$500.00 or more has been made to the Foundation. This award, consisting of a plaque and a pin, will be presented by one of the officers of the Foundation on an appropriate occasion. A plaque in the Texas Lions State Office lists all Texas Lion Fellows and the year they were designated. For each \$500 additionally donated in the name of the same person to the Texas Lions Foundation, a diamond will be added to the pin. Other levels of giving are recognized as well.

Order of the Silver Cane

The Silver Cane Award is granted to someone designated as a recipient for a donation of \$500 to World Services for the Blind. The recipient can be a Lion or non-Lion and is generally someone who has demonstrated outstanding service, such as club president or a volunteer in the community.

Jack Wiech Fellowship

The purpose pf the Jack Wiech Fellowship is to pay tribute to the founder of the Texas Lions Camp while providing material support for the ongoing operations the Texas Lions Camp. Jack Wiech served as President of the Board for the Camp's first five years and was a permanent member of the Board of Directors. Lions are invited and urged to share in this exciting venture through the Jack Wiech Fellowship. Any individual, Lions club or Lions District may choose to donate fuds as a lump sum or, spread payments over a three-year period. When contributions total \$1000, the individual named by the donor or donors becomes a Jack Wiech Fellow. Jack Wiech Fellowship may be given to individual Lions or non-Lions only; clubs, districts or other groups cannot be recipients of the Fellowship.

2-T3 Texas Eyeglass Recycling Center Fellow

There are three Vision Fellowships: Gold-\$1000; Silver-\$500; and Bronze-\$250. Each of these Fellowships recognizes a Lion for meeting the challenge of Helen Keller and the importance of financial support to the recycling center. There are various payment options: monthly, yearly and lump sum.

2-T3 Legacy Lion Award

The Legacy Lion Award provides each Lions Club in the District the opportunity to recognize an individual in their club for outstanding performance and community service during the year and/or throughout their membership. As the name implies, this individual has instilled a "LEGACY" to their club. The nominee is voted on by the club or by the Board of Directors.
