



The 5 Star Club Award recognizes the clubs within District 13 OH7 that strive to build a stronger and cohesive club by retaining current members, recruiting new members, learning new ideas from others, sharing their success, and getting to know fellow Lions through fellowship and teamwork. ### **Retention, Membership Growth, Club Visitations,**

### Helen Keller's Speech at International Convention

### Cedar Point, Ohio, USA June 30, 1925

Dear Lions and Ladies:

I suppose you have heard the legend that represents opportunity as a capricious lady, who knocks at every door but once, and if the door isn't opened quickly, she passes on, never to return. And that is as it should be. Lovely, desirable ladies won't wait. You have to go out and grab 'em.

I am your opportunity. I am knocking at your door. I want to be adopted. The legend doesn't say what you are to do when several beautiful opportunities present themselves at the same door. I guess you have to choose the one you love best. I hope you will adopt me. I am the youngest here, and what I offer you is full of splendid opportunities for service.

The American Foundation for the Blind is only four years old. It grew out of the imperative needs of the blind, and was called into existence by the sightless themselves. It is national and international in scope and in importance. It represents the best and most enlightened thought on our subject that has been reached so far. Its object is to make the lives of the blind more worthwhile everywhere by increasing their economic value and giving them the joy of normal activity.

Try to imagine how you would feel if you were suddenly stricken blind today. Picture yourself stumbling and groping at noonday as in the night; your work, your independence, gone. In that dark world wouldn't you be glad if a friend took you by the hand and said, "Come with me and I will teach you how to do some of the things you used to do when you could see?" That is just the kind of friend the American Foundation is going to be to all the blind in this country if seeing people will give it the support it must have.

You have heard how through a little word dropped from the fingers of another, a ray of light from another soul touched the darkness of my mind and I found myself, found the world, found God. It is because my teacher learned about me and broke through the dark, silent imprisonment which held me that I am able to work for myself and for others. It is the caring we want more than money. The gift without the sympathy and interest of the giver is empty. If you care, if we can make the people of this great country care, the blind will indeed triumph over blindness.

The opportunity I bring to you, Lions, is this: To foster and sponsor the work of the American Foundation for the Blind. Will you not help me hasten the day when there shall be no preventable blindness; no little deaf, blind child untaught; no blind man or woman unaided? I appeal to you Lions, you who have your sight, your hearing, you who are strong and brave and kind. Will you not constitute yourselves Knights of the Blind in this crusade against darkness?

I thank you.

# A Better World for Everyone: Assume the Responsibility!

This, however, brings up another point, the significance of which I cannot over-emphasize. Lions Clubs International has a proud tradition that has witnessed decades of selfless commitment to the ideal of voluntary service. It's a tradition that has, for 75 years, strengthened communities and resulted in healthier, more productive and better lives for millions of people around the world. But let us be able to recognize the difference between tradition and habit. Every club must be certain that its method of operation does, in fact, reflect our traditional values and attract prospective Lions who want to become members. The most obvious example in emphasizing our standing as a service club is to invite women to become members. Although the number of female Lions now number well in excess of 68,000, many clubs still have no women members. Women in every community possess the individual skills and enthusiasm to make the local Lions clubs still more effective in meeting their service obligations. They're doing it now! By the thousands! Lions clubs with women on their rolls demonstrate quite clearly that it's more important to be successful than exclusive. We must not be exclusive! Lions, I ask that you make every effort to ensure that your meeting schedules, dress codes, the manner in which meetings are skill in publicizing your conducted and club's accomplishments result in a positive image, one that will easily attract new members. Growth in membership and enhancing our image-both are crucial and they are the responsibility of every member in this association. This year marks the tenth anniversary of the Lions drug awareness program. It is a responsibility to our young people I would hope Lions never relinquish. As community leaders, we must

study the most effective ways we can help young people meet the many challenges to their own growth and futures. Toward this end, the Lions-Quest initiatives have drawn the praise of parents, teachers and school administrators for enabling young people to gain the confidence and self-esteem necessary to avoid surrendering to substance abuse. Combined, Skills for Adolescence and Skills for Growing are now taught in 33,000 schools in 27 nations and, over the years, hundreds of thousands of youngsters and their families have benefitted. Excellent totals. Lions are participating in other drug prevention programs as well, each individual effort proof of our enduring dedication in helping our young people to grow and mature in a drug-free environment. Lions clubs not yet involved in some mode of drug prevention in their communities might well celebrate the association's tenth anniversary of fighting drug abuse by embarking on a program. Upon seeing the results, you'll be glad you did. On Wednesday, the flag ceremony at this convention emphasized once again that, given the will and determination, people of varying cultures and languages and ethnic backgrounds can live in peace and harmony. In fact, every international convention is a case study in how citizens of the world can, once the opportunity presents itself, extend hands of friendship and understanding among one another. It's a triumph of global goodwill that has been a continuing success story for years. Yes, we do recognize our responsibilities to SightFirst, Campaign SightFirst and to so many other activities that heal and help. But in conjunction with our service programs, Lions Clubs International has established a marvelous record of promoting and achieving harmony and cooperation among people of nationalities spanning the globe. Lions Day with the United Nations, for example, is drawing hundreds and hundreds of Lions together, not only at U.N. headquarters in New York City, but in cities around the world, to discuss how best to join our forces in promoting lasting (Continued on page 127)

Hundreds of thousands of young people have participated in our peace poster contest over the past five years and the growth of our youth exchange and youth camp programs is still further evidence of the seriousness in which Lions view their responsibilities in bringing the people of the world together. And I am positive we can all appreciate the early accomplishments of SightFirst and untiring efforts of Campaign SightFirst in emphasizing the global humanitarian objectives of this association. Yes, it is truly our responsibility to reach out and touch someone's hand to make this a better world.
