Lions' Code of Ethics

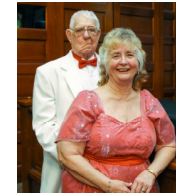
- TO SHOW** my faith in the worthiness of my vocation by industrious application to the end that I may merit a reputation for quality of service.

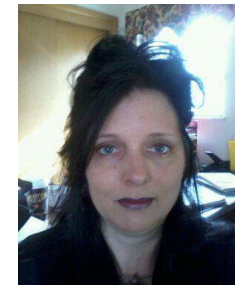

Excellent Treasurer Award (Green 7 Pin)

To qualify for the award, the Treasurer must meet 7 of the 10 requirements.

1. All International, District, and State dues must be paid by the deadline indicated on the invoice.
2. The club shall not be in arrears to International for such items as supplies, Leo Club dues, etc.
3. The Treasurer must give an accounting each month of the finances at the Club's business meeting.
4. The 990 or the 990EZ must be submitted to the IRS by November 15th of each Lions year.
5. The Treasurer must incorporate, or charge tax on non tangible items, which are sold by the Club, and must pay the tax to the State.
6. The Treasurer should see that the Club's incorporation is renewed every five (5) years.
7. The Club must have an audit of the books at the beginning of each Lions year.
8. The Treasurer must separate the funds into an Administrative and Service/Charity account.
9. The Treasurer is to assist the President in establishing the Club's Annual budget.
10. The Treasurer must attend at least 2 of the following events:
 - ☞ District Leadership School
 - ☞ Attend 2 Zone Advisory meetings
 - ☞ 2019 Lions Winter Retreat
 - ☞ 2018 District Convention
 - ☞ 2018 Ohio Lions State Convention

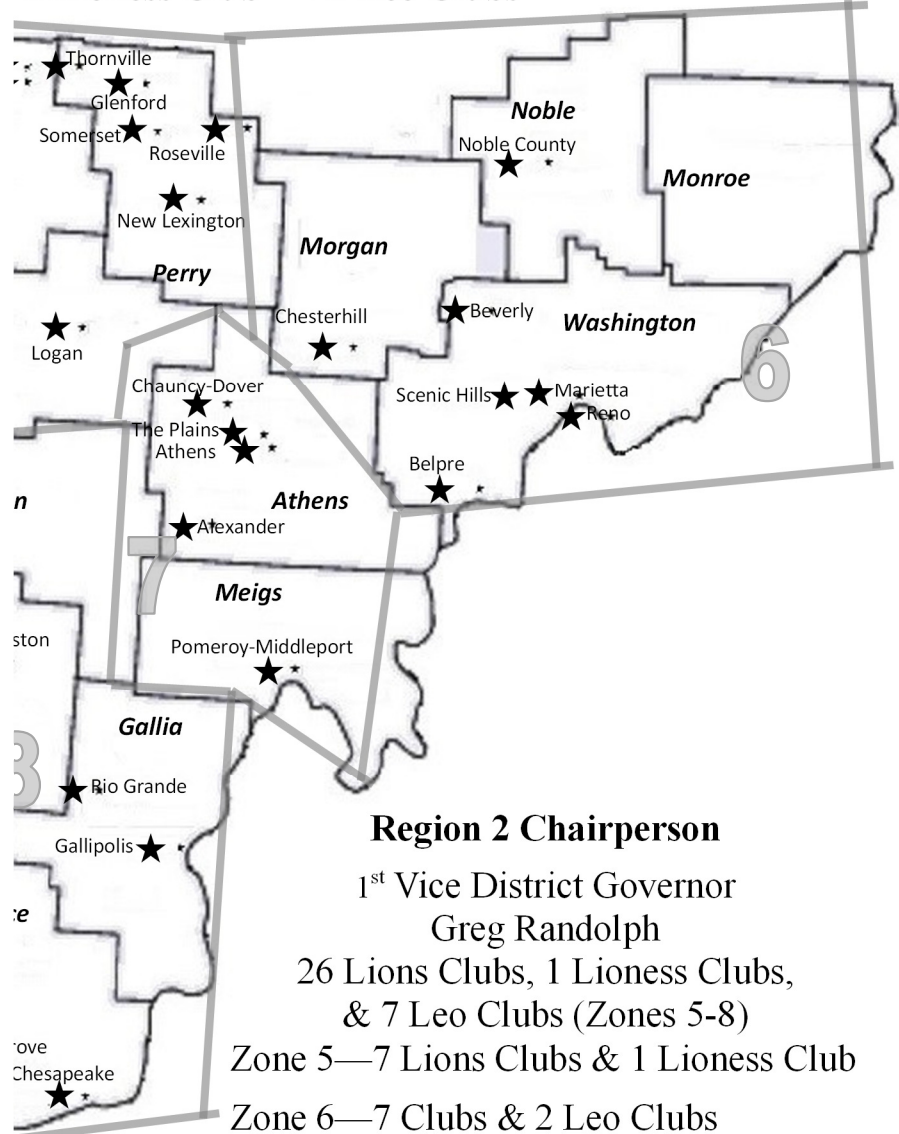

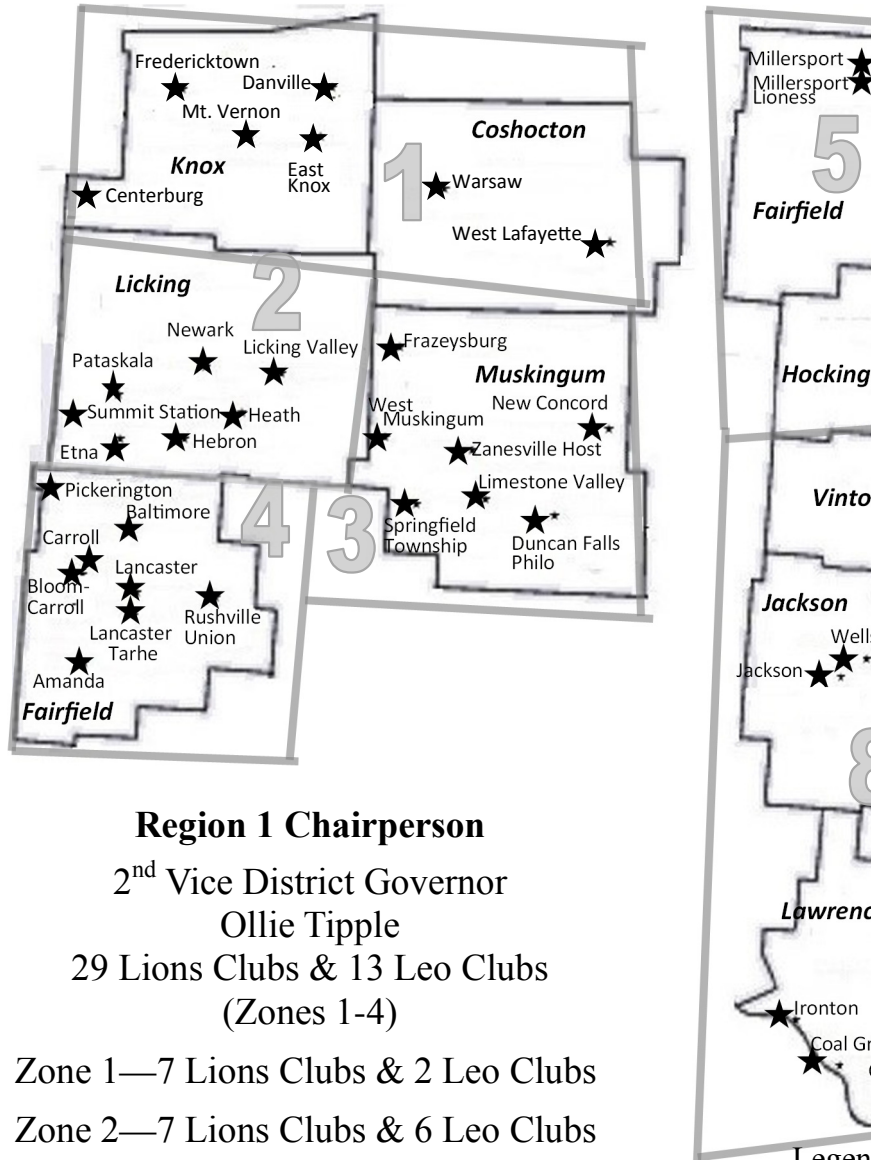
