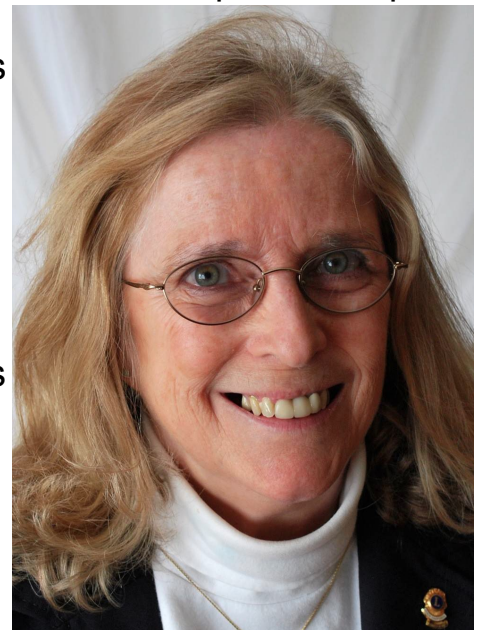

The billing for Multiple District and District 35-O for the second half of this Lions Year will be in the mail to you by the middle of January 2013. (Note: This billing is separate from the Lions Clubs International billing that you will also be receiving.)

The billing amount is determined by the number of members reported by your club on its December 2012 Membership Report plus the pro-rated dues for new members added from July 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012. If you have student members, notify the Cabinet Secretary by January 10th to receive student member credit for Multiple District dues. District 35-O does not credit discount for student members. *IMPORTANT – No adjustments should be made to the billing.* No credit is given for members dropped in January 2013.

Clubs should be prepared to promptly remit the dues upon receipt of the billing. Your cooperation in this regard will be greatly appreciated.
