

DRESS CODE

F: Formal Winter Dress:

 September 1 to April 30. Consists of Black Dinner Jacket, Black Dress Pants or Skirt, Formal Shirt, Black Tie and Black Shoes


There are several ways in which Clubs and Individuals can support this worthy Foundation:
